

**Ants** help their friends.




Never step on ants. Instead, watch them as they carry food back to their home.

Bunnies run from danger.




Some scientists do experiments on bunnies. Choose soap, shampoo, and other products that aren't tested on animals.





**Calves** drink their mother's milk.




Cow's milk is meant for calves—not us. Enjoy dairy-free foods and drinks instead.

**Dogs** like to curl up in their beds.




Dogs need to live indoors with their human families. Make sure your dog has a soft, warm bed to sleep in at night.





**Elephants** use tools.




Elephants are smart and have big brains. Don't visit roadside zoos or circuses with elephants.

**Gorillas** eat lots of plants.




Gorillas are big and strong, and they eat healthy vegan foods. Watch them on TV or read about them in books—don't go to places with gorillas in cages.

Hens and all chickens want to play and be free. Instead of eating chicken, try vegan nuggets, tofu, or a new vegetable.






**Iguanas** need lots of love and attention.

# Jellyfish are colorful.




Jellyfish sometimes get caught and die in fishing nets. Ask your family not to buy fish unless it's vegan.





**Kittens** like to play with their toys.




Kittens and all cats can get hurt or sick when they live outside. They should live indoors with their human families, where it's safe and cozy.

Narwhals have long tusks.




If we don't take care of the planet, narwhals could be in danger. You can help save them by going vegan and making the world a healthier place.

**Octopuses** can change the color of their skin.




Octopuses belong in nature, not in small tanks. Learn about octopuses on the internet instead of visiting marine parks.

**Quails** snuggle to keep warm.




Quails have beautiful feathers. Some people eat quails and their eggs, but they don't want to be eaten.

**Umbrellabirds** help spread seeds throughout the rainforest.




Umbrellabirds are in danger of losing their natural habitat. You can help them by going vegan because growing vegan food uses less land.





Vipers lie in the sunshine.




Vipers are poisonous snakes. They don't make good animal companions—or purses or boots, either. Let snakes live—never buy them from pet stores or wear their skin as clothing.





Walruses have long tusks.




In nature, walruses live in large groups, but in marine parks, they're kept in small tanks with nothing to do.

Never visit places that keep animals in tanks.






X-ray fish have see-through skin.



X-ray fish are often kept in aquariums. Imagine having to live in a small glass tank for the rest of your life! Never buy fish from pet stores.





Yellow jackets have a special language to communicate with each other.



Yellow jackets are also called "wasps," and they use special chemicals to tell others where food or danger is. Stay away from their nests and they'll leave you alone.

**Speciesism** is the harmful idea that humans are more important than other animals, but we know that it's not true. All animals deserve kindness and respect.






#### Species
