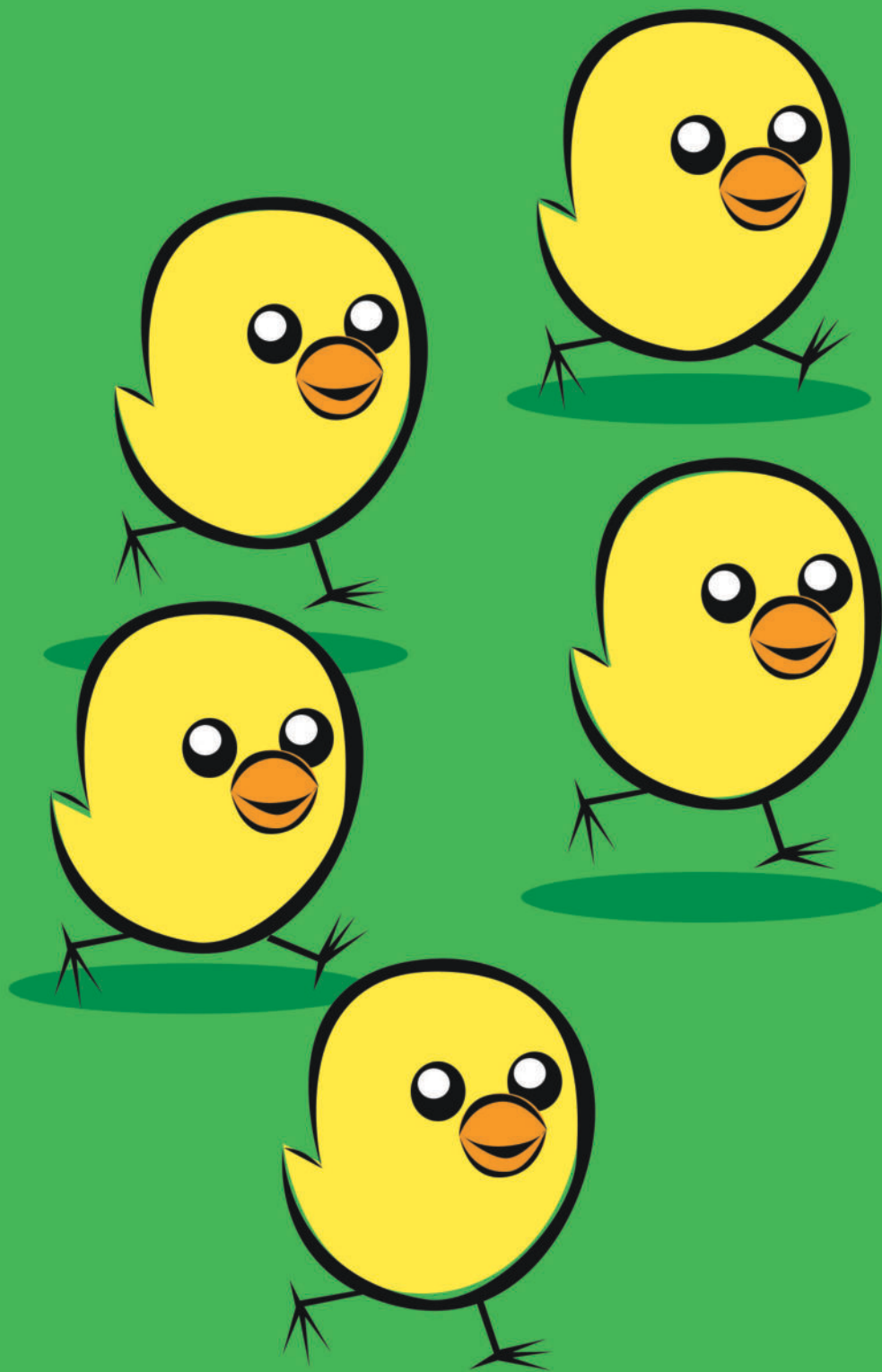

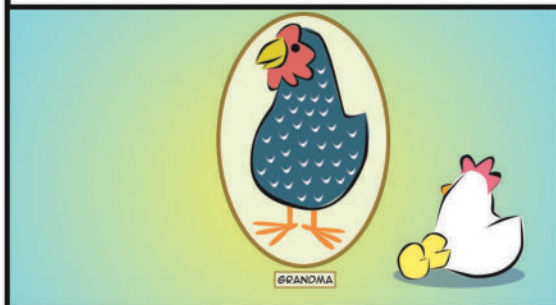
AWESOME CHICKENS!

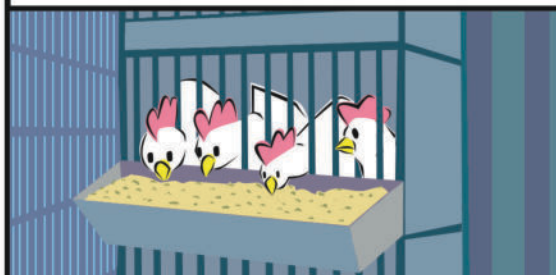
ALL DOMESTIC CHICKENS ARE RELATED TO *GALLUS GALLUS*, THE RED JUNGLE FOWL.



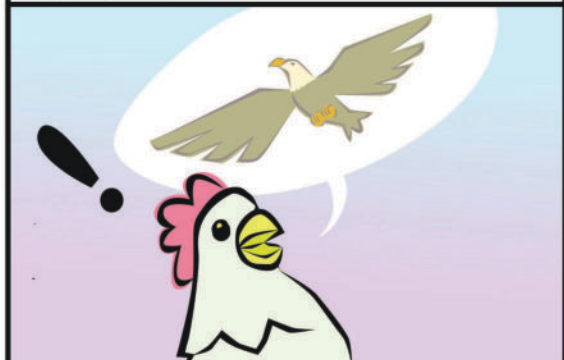

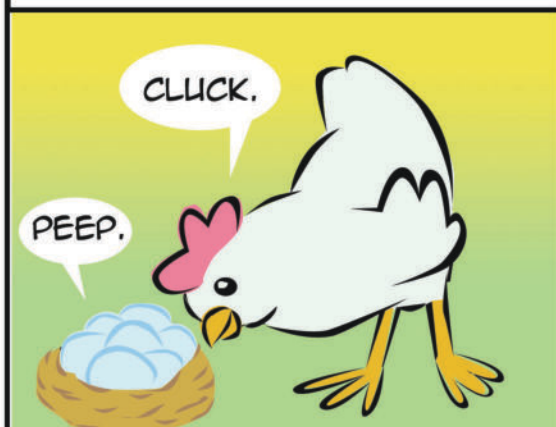

HENS AND CHICKS TALK WITH EACH OTHER ... EVEN WHILE THE CHICK IS STILL INSIDE THE EGG!



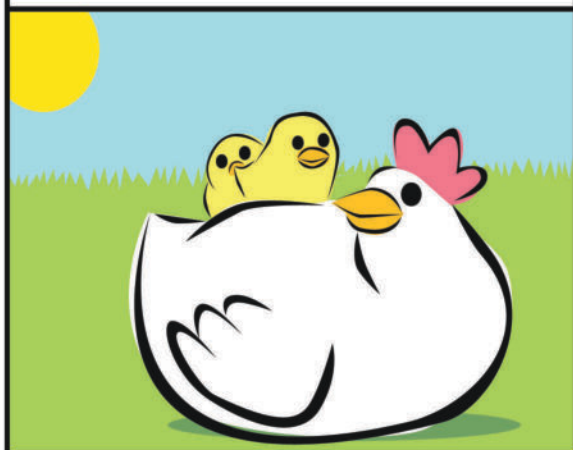

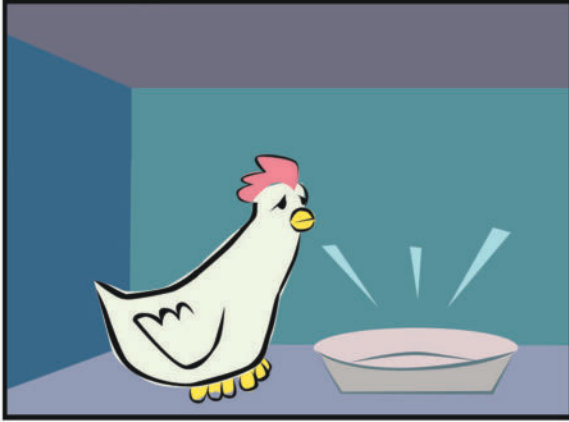




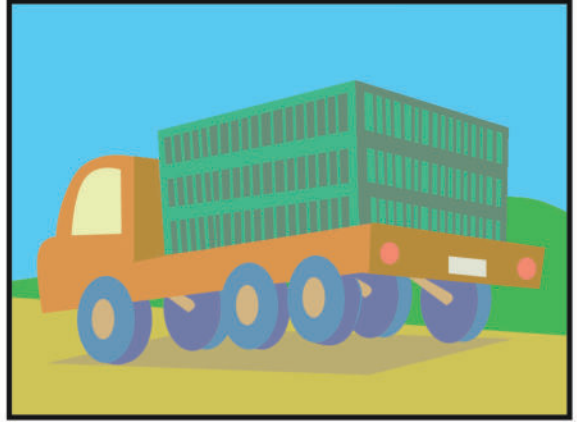




SHE WAS SO BORED, LONELY, AND SCARED. ALL SHE COULD DO WAS SIT THERE.



ONE DAY, ALL THE CHICKENS WERE LOADED ONTO A TRUCK AND SENT TO A SLAUGHTERHOUSE.



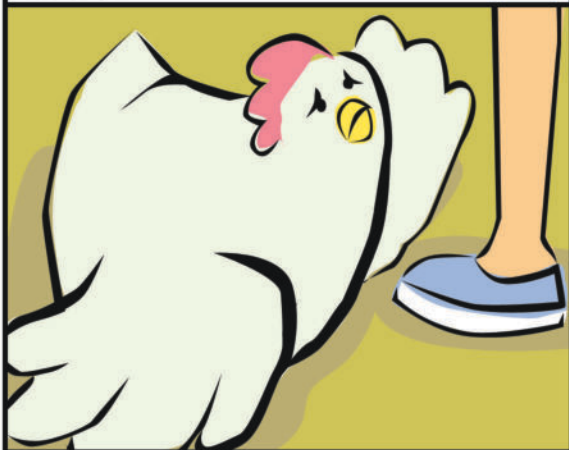

WE TOOK HER TO THE VET, WHO GAVE HER SOME MEDICINE, AND BROUGHT HER BACK HERE.



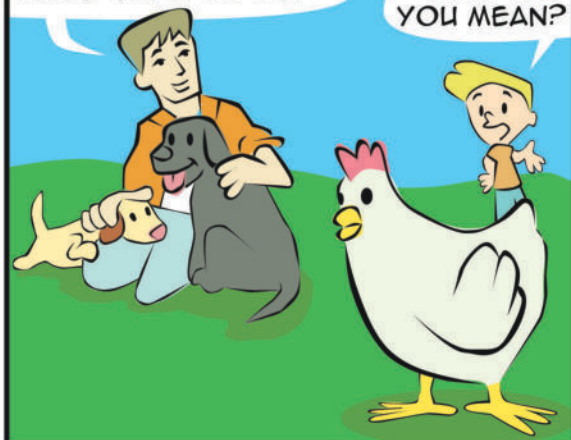

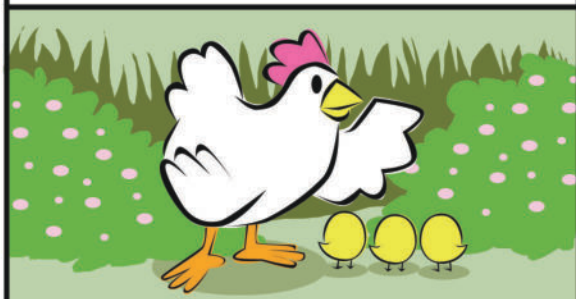




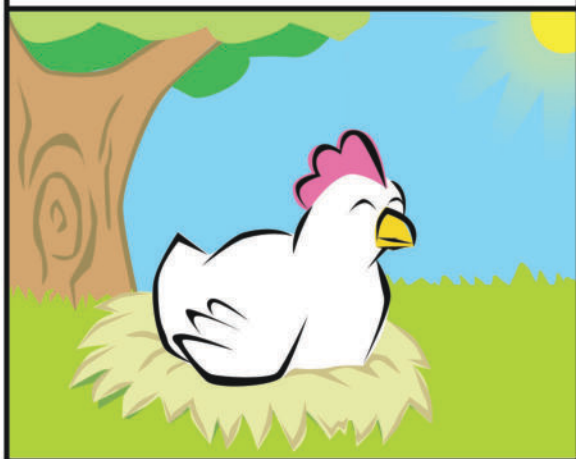


NATURE'S WAY

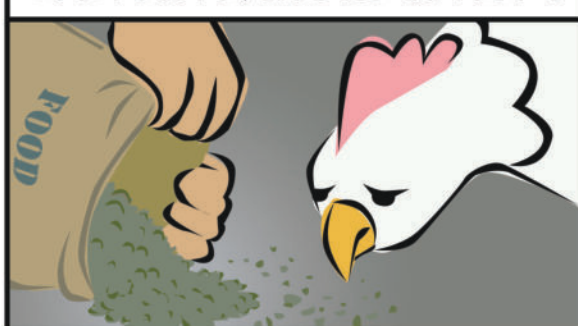
EGGS ARE TAKEN FROM HENS AND SOLD IN STORES FOR FOOD.



CHICKENS ARE KEPT IN WIRE CAGES AND AREN'T GIVEN ANY MATERIALS TO MAKE NESTS.



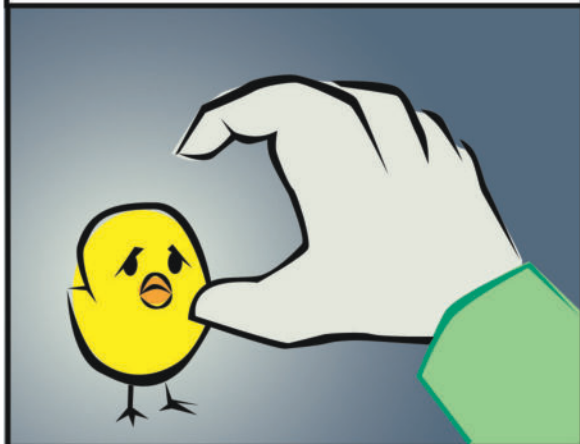

AWESOME RATS! RATS ARE FASCINATING ANIMALS! DID YOU KNOW ...



RATS HAVE POOR EYESIGHT BUT EXCELLENT SENSES OF SMELL, TASTE, TOUCH, AND HEARING.



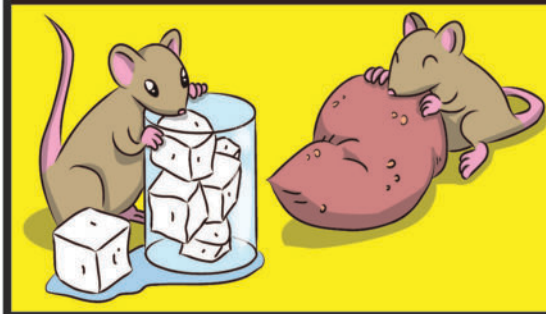

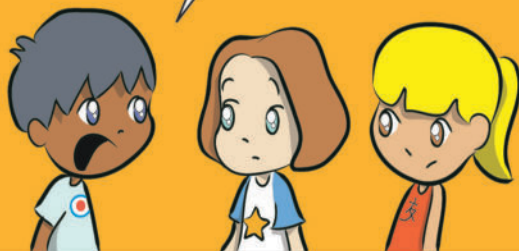


DO THEY REALLY WORK?

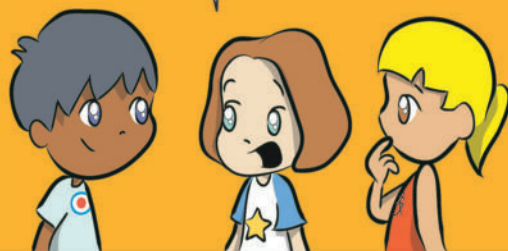

MOLLY NEVER WENT IN THE HOUSE AGAIN.

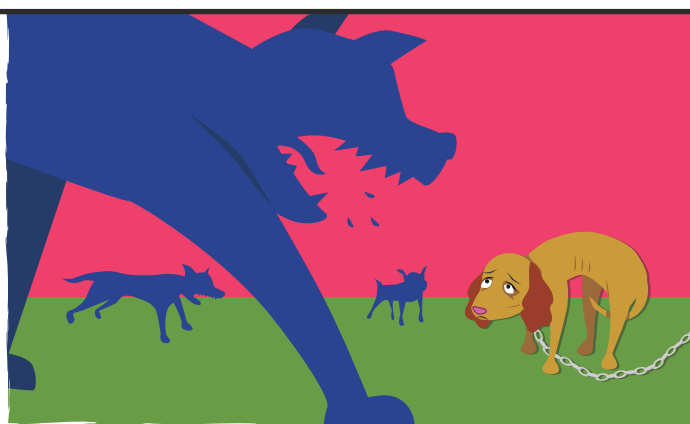

IN THE WINTER, SHE COULD NEVER GET WARM AND HAD NOWHERE TO SLEEP BUT THE COLD, HARD GROUND.



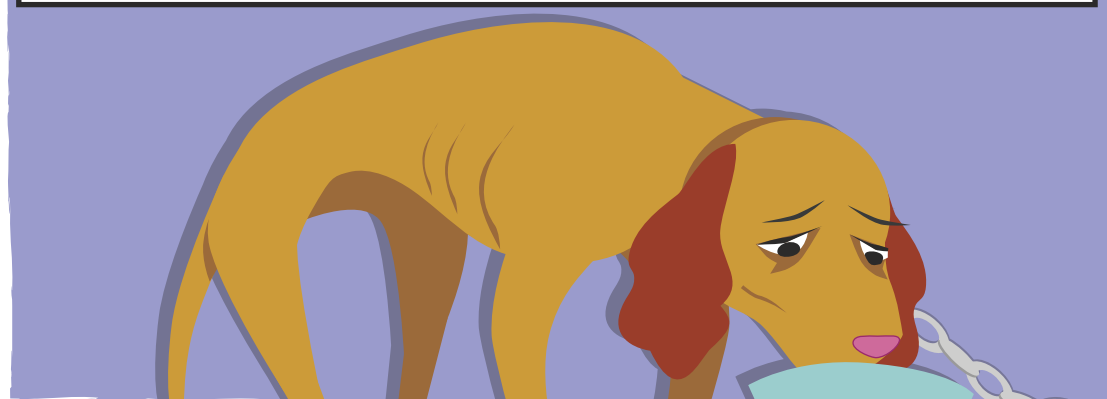

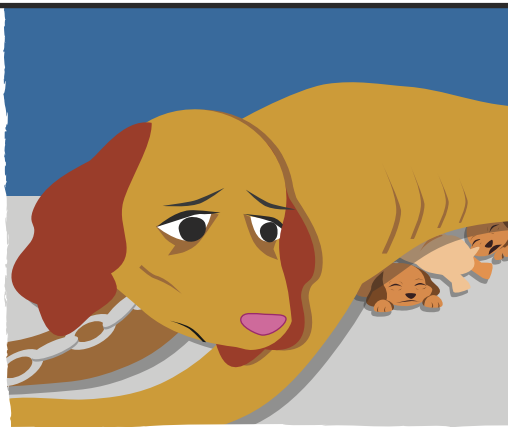

BUT WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO HER?



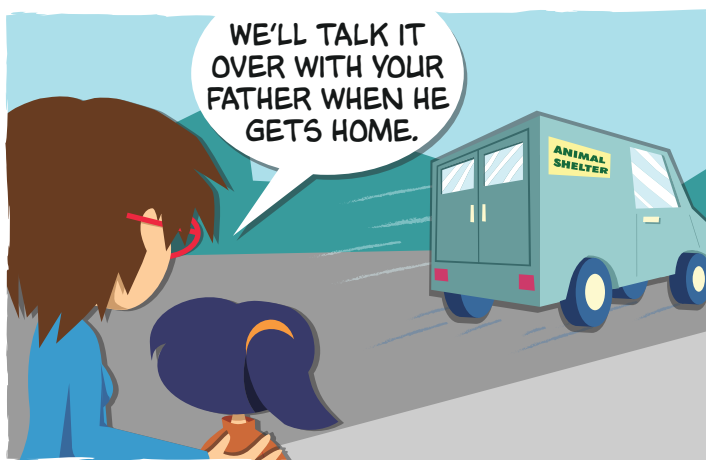
